

Dear Senator,



President Trump's nomination of Brett Kavanaugh puts women's constitutional rights, including access to reproductive healthcare and abortion, at risk. You know Trump only acts in his own self-interest – that's why he has nominated a judge who does not believe a sitting president can be indicted.

The process has been flawed from the start and it became all the more galling when allegations of attempted rape against Brett Kavanaugh surfaced. It's simple: You either stand with Dr. Christine Blasey Ford and believe survivors, or you send us the message that abusers should be rewarded with even more power.

A Senate confirmation for Brett Kavanaugh will turn the balance of the Supreme Court against women's constitutional rights, an impact that will last for generations to come.

Trump promised to nominate only justices who would overturn *Roe v. Wade* and dismantle the Affordable Care Act (ACA), and he's following through. That means women's control over our bodies, families, and futures are on the line. This is a life or death decision.

We need and deserve a justice who will protect the constitutional rights of all people, not just the wealthy and powerful. We need a justice who believes that the Constitution protects the individual right of all people to make personal decisions about their bodies and relationships – including the rights to use birth control and have an abortion. We need a justice who will uphold the rights, freedoms, and opportunities for everyone, no matter our race, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender, or where we come from.

To protect my rights, and the rights of my family and community, I'm asking you, as my Senator, to reject Judge Kavanaugh's nomination to the Supreme Court.

I will be paying close attention, and you can be assured that a vote to confirm Brett Kavanaugh does not represent me as a constituent, and that I will remember the outcome of this vote in the next election.
